Effective August 1, 2019, Act 393 amends La R.S. 40:1203.3 (A) (!) and indicates that no employer shall hire any licensed ambulance personnel or non-licensed person when the results of a criminal history check reveals that the licensed ambulance personnel or non-licensed person has been convicted of the crime of identity theft or the crime of abuse of persons with infirmities through electronic means.
